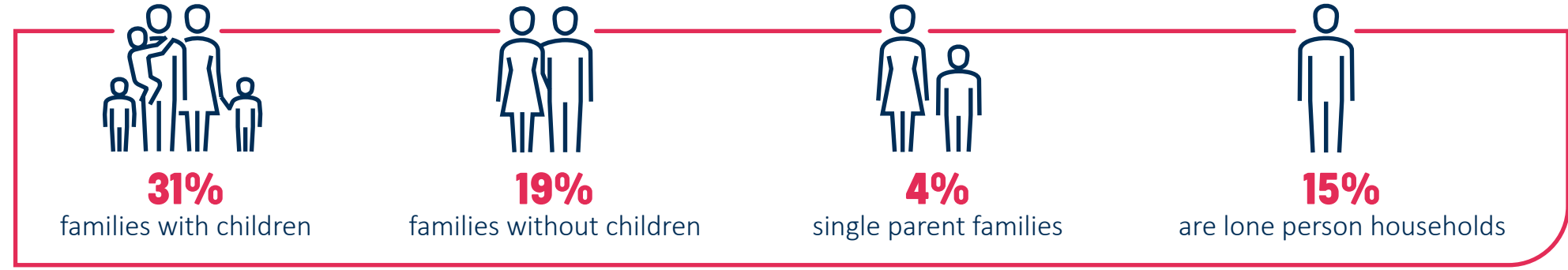


Wyndham City

Covering an area of 542km², the City of Wyndham is located in Melbourne's outer south-western suburbs, between 12 and 45 kilometres from the Melbourne CBD. The Traditional Owners of the land are the Bunurong and Wadawurrung peoples of the Kulin Nation. The City of Wyndham is made up of 17 suburbs with a population of nearly 300,000 people. Since 2016, the population of Wyndham has increased by 34.5 per cent.

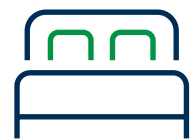

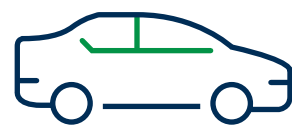
