- Paper plate
- Paper
- Pencils/textas
- Glue
- Scissors

What to do:

- 1. Draw a spaceship design on the paper plate. You can use my image below or draw your own. Colour in the spaceship
- 2. To make the wings on the spaceship, fold a piece of paper in half and glue it together. Draw a diagonal line and cut this out so you have two long triangles.
- 3. Colour the wings in and cut them so they fit on the spaceship. See the images here to help you with the layout and shape. Stick them onto the spaceship and your Millennium Falcon is complete!
