

Dear Acting CEO,

The following councillors, undersigned, request that an urgent Special Council Meeting be called in accordance with 11.1 of the Wyndham City Council Governance Rules to be held on Tuesday 25th May at 6.00pm at the Wyndham City Council offices, 45 Princes Highway Werribee. The meeting will consider the following business:

- That Council endorses an application of alleged misconduct lodged by the Mayor through the internal arbitration process after receipt of concerning material in relation to the conduct of Cr Maynard involving a member of our community;
- That Council calls on Cr Maynard to step down as Deputy Mayor due to the ongoing risk of council being brought into disrepute until the investigation into his conduct has concluded and the findings are provided to Council for consideration; and
- Notes that the referral to an independent arbitration hearing on this matter should consider the following additional factors:
 - a) That Cr Maynard has indicated he will apologise to the victim for his actions but notes that Cr Maynard has also advised councillors that he would engage in the same behaviour again when asked for an explanation of his actions;
 - b) That this is not the first time Cr Maynard has apologised for inappropriate conduct towards a resident. In light of this, council doesn't deem a written apology to be a sufficient resolution to this further instance of behaviour; and
 - That council has a zero tolerance of elected representatives verbally abusing members of our community.
