

What does Council do?

- Remove all offensive graffiti on Wyndham Council assets within 1 working day; remove all other graffiti on Wyndham Council assets within 3 working days
- Conduct graffiti education programs throughout local primary and secondary schools
- Compile tag reports for Victoria Police to investigate
- Conduct routine audits throughout the municipality to locate graffiti and arrange prompt removal
- Establish partnerships with community groups, residents & local businesses to help reduce the impact of graffiti throughout the municipality
- Create preventative murals in graffiti 'hot spot' locations
- Implement and manage legal 'hit up' walls.
Council currently has 2 legal spaces located at:
 - 70 Bolton Road, Wyndham Vale
 - 70 Rosella Avenue, Werribee



How can I help Prevent Graffiti from Occurring on my Property?

- Install a sensor light and/or CCTV
- Work with your neighbours to increase vigilance throughout the area

- Promptly remove all graffiti from your property to discourage graffiti vandals from re-offending (Seek removal assistance from Council's Graffiti Team where required)

Graffiti Offences and Penalties

The penalties for graffiti vandalism and other graffiti-related offences under the Victorian Graffiti Prevention Act 2007 are:

- Marking publicly visible graffiti, or offensive graffiti, on private property without the owner's consent - up to 2 years prison and a maximum fine of \$38,057
- Possessing, without lawful excuse, a spray paint can while on or adjacent to public transport property or infrastructure, or where the person is trespassing on private property - a maximum fine of \$3,964 or an on-the-spot fine of \$793
- Possessing a graffiti implement with the intention of marking graffiti - a maximum fine of \$3,964

The Graffiti Management Policy has been designed to outline Wyndham City Council's commitment towards the management of illegal graffiti throughout our municipality. It is based on three key areas: Prevention, Removal and Enforcement.

What Happens When I Report Graffiti?

Wyndham City Council has a dedicated Graffiti Management Team who responds to incidents of graffiti throughout the municipality and arranges rapid removal.
