



Connecting to WiFi at the Library

Each library branch has free wifi. Use this guide to help you connect.

On an iPhone or iPad:

1. Open **Settings**
 2. Choose **Wi-Fi**
 3. Tap on the **name** of the library branch you are at (eg Wyndham Vale Library) to connect to that network.
 4. **Accept** the library's terms and conditions
- You are now connected to the internet!

On a Windows laptop:

1. Click on the **wifi** icon in the bottom right hand corner of your screen
 2. Click on the **name** of the library branch you are at (eg Wyndham Vale Library) to connect to that network.
 3. Open **Internet Explorer**
 4. Type in www.google.com
 5. **Accept** the library's terms and conditions
- You are now connected to the internet!

Using an Android phone or Tablet

1. Open **Settings**
 2. Choose **Wi-Fi**
 3. Tap on the **name** of the library branch you are at (eg Wyndham Vale Library) to connect to that network.
 4. Open a web browser: **Internet Browser** or **Chrome**
 5. Type in www.google.com
 6. **Accept** the library's terms and conditions
- You are now connected to the internet!

Troubleshooting

If you can't access the wifi, check that your wireless transmitter is switched on. Most laptops have a switch or button that turns on the wireless transmitter. This could be a button or switch on the keypad or on the side of the laptop. It will usually have a symbol like the following:
