# ADVENTURES IN AVIATION



This is sacred ground – the only base of its kind on the national heritage listing.

Fancy clambering inside the bomb bay of a historic military plane? Or treading hallowed turf where a boxkite plane embarked on Australia's maiden military flight? In Werribee and surrounds, aviation adventures abound.

Step back to the 1940s (and into that bomb bay) at the **B-24 Liberator** hangar. Get to know what drives 35+ volunteers to spend decades restoring the only B-24 Liberator this side of the equator. Behold her shiny patchwork fuselage, bend the ear of a flight fanatic, fossick through memorabilia and feel the raw power of engine run day.

Across the highway, the **RAAF Museum** at Point Cook is ground zero for the largest collection of historic military aircraft in the Southern Hemisphere and birthplace of the Australian Flying Corps and Royal Australian Airforce (RAAF). Wander through hangars of original and replica aircraft, multimedia displays and exhibitions. Get up close to the action of an Interactive Flying Display and delve into daring tales of pioneering aviators.

## THE SKY'S THE LIMIT

You just need to pre-book your adventure. Is a joy flight high on your wish list? Zip up your flying jacket, don your goggles and feel the wind on your face as you loop and roll through the airspace. **Vintage Tiger Moth Joy Flights** supply all the gear and all the thrills.

Step it up a notch or two with serious learn-to-fly airtime at the **Point Cook Flying Club**. You don't need a wing or a prayer to enjoy an evening trial flight in a powered parachute at **Aerochute**.

Held right on our border at Avalon Airport, the bi-annual **Australian International Airshow** is a must-do for plane spotters. Billed as the ultimate family adventure, the airshow fills the skies with jet fighters, bombers, helicopters and aerial aerobatics.



Tiptoe through nature-filled wetlands. Wander an uncrowded trail on the banks of a river or edge of the sea. Find your happy place where big city bustle gives way to open space and fresh air.

Don't be fooled by its name: **Western Treatment Plant** is much more natural than it sounds! Its multiple habitats host an abundance of flora and fauna. Book an education tour to grasp the true wonder of this world-leading technical and environmental innovation. Curious? Explore Cocoroc, an abandoned town that once housed families of plant workers.

The **Werribee River** winds through the region's heart. Shared trails and linear parks fringe its banks from the Werribee City Centre to the suburbs, from the tourist precinct to the wetlands.

Marvel at the naturally formed **K Road Cliffs** towering above the river. Stroll, cycle, fish, kayak or simply relax and be at one with the world.

**Point Cook Marine Sanctuary** teems with underwater possibility. Dive the Henrietta shipwreck or snorkel to spot a pipefish lurking in the seagrass.

Find more nature at: **Point Cook Coastal Park** and **Cheetham Wetlands, Werribee South Foreshore and Heathdale Wetlands.**

## FINDING FEATHERED FRIENDS

Finally glimpsing that Orange-bellied Parrot you've stalked for the longest time. Kids' excitement as they spy a Glossy Ibis from a wetlands' bird hide. Gazing at a Wedge-tailed Eagle soaring effortlessly above ancient River Red Gums. Whether you're a pro twitcher or a newbie, you'll be swept up in birdwatching moments in Werribee and surrounds, where the diversity is considered second only to Kakadu.

Flock to the **Western Treatment Plant**, a Ramsar listed wetland site with hundreds of recorded bird species, some rare and endangered. Pick up a day pass at the Plant or for interstate or international visitors at the Werribee Visitor Information Centre.

Head to any of our many natural environments – from the zoo to the foreshore to the river – to spot feathered friends, both rare and ubiquitous. Sling binoculars around your neck, charge up the camera and grab a birdwatching brochure from the Visitor Information Centre before you set out.

# Wyndham's Hidden Diversity

Wyndham's natural environment is extremely diverse and beautifully unique. Our native flora, fauna and vegetation communities are of national and international importance including the nationally significant Natural Temperate Grassland of the Victorian Volcanic Plain. We have 27.4km of coastline along Port Phillip Bay for you to explore, some of which is listed on the international Ramsar Convention.

Wyndham is home to many wetlands, some remnant and some constructed for water treatment. Our wetlands provide great habitat for a variety of wildlife for you to see.

So get out there and explore some of the spectacular natural sites of Wyndham.

# Point Cook Coastal Park

## Point Cook Marine Sanctuary

Experience a rich natural and historical environment in this remarkably large, and seemingly remote park setting close to Melbourne.

Relax and picnic alongside a migratory bird habitat of international significance, a marine sanctuary and historical homestead.

### Beach picnic area

The beach picnic area is the perfect place for a family picnic with gas BBQs, picnic tables, shade shelters, toilets, a children's playground and beach access. The park is crossed by kilometres of mowed grass tracks and good walking is available along the beach at low tide.

### Birdlife

Each year, thousands of migratory birds arrive from the northern hemisphere winter to enjoy the wetlands habitat of Port Phillip Bay. Visitors may see Greenshanks, Sharp-tailed Sandpipers, Red-necked Stints, Curlew Sandpipers, Marsh Sandpipers and Pacific Golden Plovers. Numbers reach a peak between September and March.

### Cheetham Wetlands

Nearby Cheetham Wetlands are also a natural bird haven, formed from the salt marshes and lagoons of Skeleton Creek. Enjoy beautiful views of the city and the You Yangs. The adventurous will enjoy the magnificent 360 degree view from the Tower built as a dedication to "Migration and Aspirations".

### Getting there


Turn off the Princes Freeway at the Point Cook Road exit. Travel for 6km to the main entrance.




