



## ROAD & KERB CONDITION INSPECTION

### What we're doing...

We are undertaking an assessment of the municipality's 1356km road network. Inspection work will begin Monday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2017 and last approximately three weeks.

#### How's this happening:

- These activities are undertaken by council's asset inspection contractor, Infrastructure Management Group as an asset management initiative to obtain detailed video imaging and condition assessment of the community's road and drainage assets.
- You may observe camera equipped, transporter style inspection vehicles traveling on local roads around your work, residences or other locations within the municipality during this period.
- The assessment vehicles are driven by experienced operators travelling at normal traffic speeds with hazard lighting & other warning devices in operation while completing laser measurement and video recording activities of the region's roads.
- Vehicles are clearly identifiable and will operate seamlessly within the normal surrounding traffic patterns. Although following vehicles are asked to keep a full car length distance to provide the rear cameras with a clear view of the road surface.
- We thank you for your assistance during this period of works and look forward to providing the benefits of this exercise.

### How this affects you...

#### Your Privacy :

All cameras are focused on the road and kerb surface structure with some limited viewing of areas directly adjacent. No image recordings of commercial or residential, private properties or structures will be undertaken.

#### The Benefits :

The information gained from this exercise will enable better management of this important community asset, enabling more effective maintenance and renewal strategies and improving the connectivity mobility & safety.

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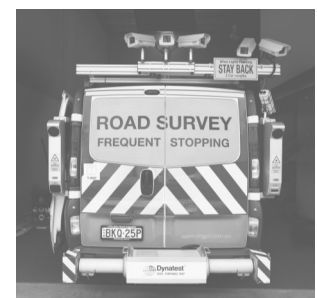
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
