\$10M funding will create 100 new jobs in Wyndham



Local companies **Unipod** and **TFI Group** both successfully bid for Victorian State Government funding under the Local Industry Fund for Transition (LIFT) program. The LIFT fund gives grants of up to \$2m to businesses which can create jobs in areas affected by the closure of automotive manufacturing.

Unipod manufactures expanded polystyrene waffle pods which are used to build concrete slabs for new homes, extensions and other commercial industrial buildings. Their grant will assist the funding of a major expansion with \$9.8m to be invested in building a world-class manufacturing plant in Truganina. The company will soon take on 92 new employees including 85 roles which will be suitable for former automotive workers.

In a further boost for auto workers in Melbourne's west, TFI Group (Total Fleet Imaging) in Laverton North received a LIFT grant to create eight new

jobs and expand its signage operations.

Target Australia moving to Williams Landing



Target Australia is moving its headquarters from North Geelong to Williams Landing, the master planned development by Cedar Woods.

Target has signed a 10-year lease agreement with Cedar Woods for a 12,600 square metre office building over eight levels. It will cater for 850 employees and be located adjacent to Williams Landing train station.

Construction of the building will begin this year and is expected to be completed by the end of 2018.

Save money & improve the environmental performance of your business



Plastic container manufacturer and distributor, **Class Plastics**, has installed a super solar system on the building they lease in Truganina. The company signed an **Environmental Upgrade Agreement** (EUA) with Wyndham City and the Sustainable Melbourne Fund to install a 365 kilowatt solar system.

An EUA is an agreement between the owner of a building, a bank and Wyndham City that facilitates a building upgrade to improve its environmental performance.

Many commercial tenants are unable to make changes to the building that they lease and EUAs make this possible.

Various types of renewable energy and energy efficiency projects (such as solar panels and lighting upgrades) are eligible.

Energy Assessment Grants

Small and medium sized businesses (SMEs) that spend more than \$20,000 per annum on energy can cut energy costs and increase productivity with the help of an energy assessment grant.

On average, SMEs can expect to find over \$50,000 of potential energy savings per year.

The grants are offered at two funding levels - up to \$2,000 for a basic energy assessment and up to \$6,000 for a detailed energy assessment on a matched funding (\$1:\$1) basis.

Successful applicants can also access a \$3,000 bonus to help implement one or more of the recommendations in the energy efficiency assessment.
