

#### **Wyndham City leading the business community**

Wyndham City is leading the way when it comes to good business

practices, becoming the first Council in Australia to sign the Australian Supplier Payment Code.

By signing the Code, Council has pledged to pay eligible small business suppliers within 30 days of receiving a correct invoice and to help suppliers implement new technologies and practices that speed up invoicing.

We encourage all businesses that deal with small business to implement systems and processes that ensure 30 day payment.

#### **Highest population growth in Wyndham**

Wyndham's population has grown more than any other municipality in Victoria over the last five years, according to census figures recently released – a 34.4% increase.

Wyndham is followed by Casey, Whittlesea, Melbourne and Hume.

Point Cook has become the largest suburb in Wyndham with a population of almost 50,000 in 2016, up from just over 32,000 in 2011.

Similar high growth took place in Tarneit, Truganina, Williams Landing and Wyndham Vale.

The Fair Work Commission has announced an increase of 3.3% to the national minimum wage following its annual wage review.

From 1 July 2017, the national minimum wage will increase to \$694.90 per week or \$18.29 per hour.

The decision also affects base rates of pay in modern awards.
