ABOUT WYNDHAM

The City of Wyndham is located on the western edge of Melbourne, between the metropolitan area and Geelong. Wyndham covers an area of 542km² and features 27.4 km of coastline bordering Port Phillip to the east. The municipality is situated in one of Australia's most productive regions, part of the largest area of rich basalt soils on the continent. Wyndham is adjacent to the municipalities of Greater Geelong, Moorabool, Melton, Brimbank and Hobsons Bay.

WYNDHAM POPULATION

The population of Wyndham is 217,122 persons (correct to August 2016)²

Since 2011, 55,545 new residents have settled in Wyndham; on average over 11,000 additional residents each year.

WYNDHAM'S GROWTH

WYNDHAM WAS THE SECOND FASTEST GROWING MUNICIPALITY IN VICTORIA BETWEEN 2011 AND 2016

- Population increase of 34% (55,545 persons)²

There are approximately 12 babies born each day in Wyndham, a total of 4,473 births in 2016-17⁵



HEALTH AND WELLBEING³

27.8% OF PEOPLE IN WYNDHAM SELF-REPORT HAVING EXCELLENT OR VERY GOOD HEALTH

- 43.5% of persons meet the guidelines for fruit intake
- 35.2% reported sufficient times and sessions of physical activity per week
- 57.8% of people are overweight or obese

HOW OLD ARE WE?²

WYNDHAM IS EXPERIENCING GROWTH ACROSS ALL AGE GROUPS

- The largest age group is 30 to 34 years, with a population of 23,466 people. This is followed by 0 to 4 years with 21,381 persons
- Between 2011 and 2016 the number of persons aged under 19 grew by 17,507 (36%)
- Between 2016 and 2036, age structure forecasts indicate a 143% increase in the population of retirement aged residents (65+ years)

THE MAJORITY OF RESIDENTS TRAVEL TO WORK BY CAR (72%) WHILE ONLY 11% USE PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- 5% of people travel to work by train
- 6% of residents car pooled to work travelled to work as passenger
- 836 (1.1%) employees walked to work
- 60% of residents own two or more cars

EDUCATION

- aged 15 years and over hold no post schooling qualifications⁶
- 18% of Wyndham residents aged 15 years and over hold vocational gualifications⁶
- 19% of Wyndham residents aged 15 years or over hold bachelor degree or higher qualifications⁶

WYNDHAM'S DIVERSITY

42% OF WYNDHAM'S POPULATION WERE BORN OVERSEAS²

- The top five countries of birth of Wyndham residents (other than Australia) were India, New Zealand, the Philippines, China and England²
- 22% of Wyndham residents were affiliated with a non-Christian religion²
- 41% of people speak a language other than English at home²

WYNDHAM'S FIRST PEOPLES²

Wyndham has the largest population in the western metro Melbourne area of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.


- There are 72,462 jobs in Wyndham - a 9% increase since 2014
