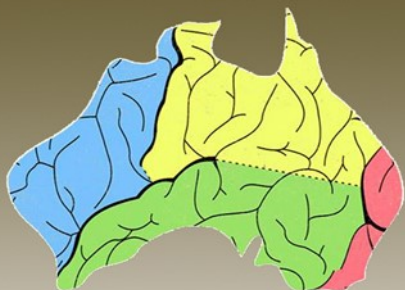

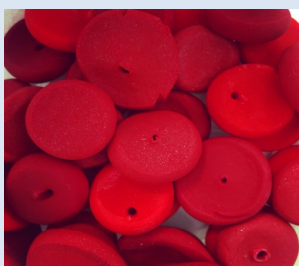

STAY HEALTHY

Saltwater teamed up with The Stroke Foundation, IPC Health, local Artist Carolyn Langford-Warren and barista extraordinaire Frank Torres to host a very special event for Stroke Week in September. 65 participants received a free health check and assessment courtesy of IPC nurses, a free coffee and the chance to make their own ceramic red blood cell (see picture), which could be worn as a pin or pendant as a reminder to make an appointment for an annual check up.

Every 10 minutes, an Australian has a stroke and they can happen at any age. Many are easily preventable, so if you didn't get a health check at the Centre, make time to make an appointment for a routine check up with your GP.



Know the warning signs of a stroke:

F—Face, is it drooping?

A—Arms, can they lift both?

S—Speech, is it slurred?

T—Time is critical, call 000 if you see any of these three symptoms.
