

WHAT IS THE PROJECT?

The aims of the facility activation project are:

- To provide the community the opportunity to access underutilised sporting facilities throughout the day, specifically between 6am-4pm. This timeslot has been identified as one where many council facilities are sitting dormant.
- The project aims to support individuals and groups within the Wyndham community by building awareness and participation in sport and recreation available to people of all ages, abilities and backgrounds.
- Encourage people to become active through sport and promote the physical, social and mental health benefits of an active lifestyle.
- Engage local community groups, state sporting associations, not-forprofit organisations, schools, local clubs and individuals in delivering local sport and recreation activities that support physical and mental health and community connection.



WHO CAN ACCESS A FACILITY?

Facilities can be accessed during weekdays between 6am-4pm. All individuals and groups within the community can access each facility to undertake sport and recreation activities of preference. There is great flexibility with how the facilities are utilised.

HOW DO I ACCESS A FACILITY?

- Contact a staff member to make an enquiry regarding the use of a facility.
- Meet with staff member to go through short induction process which includes booking forms, facility operations and understanding of policy and procedures.
- Develop aims and objectives of activation.
- Sign documents and activate the facility.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

- Develop sport and recreation programs for the community of Wyndham.
- Your own space and privacy to utilise the facility with no interruptions.
- The use of large indoor and outdoor space providing program flexibility.
- Secure a long term home which can be used multiple times a week.
