



PARK AMENITIES

Drinking fountains, rubbish bins, bicycle parking, lighting, entry and directional signage, and a range of seating areas will be provided throughout the reserve. Shade will be provided to play spaces and picnic areas.

1. WESTERN ENTRY

Park entry with new fencing, signage, feature paving and improved pedestrian and cyclist access off Werribee Street.

2. RAINGARDEN

Natural treatment area for stormwater run-off from surrounding streets before it enters the Werribee River.

3. NATURE TRAIL AND FITNESS LOOP

Walking paths, seating, and river viewing through the picturesque, riverside areas of the reserve. This area will be planted with locally indigenous food plants and other species to improve habitat for native animals and for education activities. Paths through this area will form part of a broader fitness circuit within the reserve with distance markers. Fitness equipment stations may be incorporated along the circuit.

4. WYNDHAM PARK ADVENTURE PLAYSPACE

Exciting and challenging play area for 8+ years with a range of features including: an iconic play tower with giant slide, spinning equipment, double flying fox, adventure rope course and tall swings overlooking the park.

5. PARTY AND PLAY

Social space and picnic area with BBQs, shelter, and banquet style picnic tables for large social gatherings.

6. DOG PARK - FUTURE STAGE TO BE CONFIRMED

Fenced off leash dog park with seating, drinking fountain, and rubbish bins.

7. CHILL-OUT TERRACE

Relaxed seating, informal picnic and viewing area with wifi overlooking the main events space.

8. GRASS EMBANKMENT AND EVENTS VIEWING

9. EVENTS LAWN

3000m² irrigated lawn area for markets, festivals, performances, informal ball games and social sports.

10. WYNDHAM PARK BRIDGE ENTRY

Main arrival space with feature paving, mobile cafe, public toilets, entry signage, terraced seating steps for meeting and viewing of events and other reserve activities. Ramped access will be provided from this area to the lower level.

11. ACTIVITY AREA - FUTURE STAGE TO BE CONFIRMED

Hard surface multi-purpose area with basketball hoop, skate-able features, climbing wall, wifi, ping pong, and conversation spaces.

12. RIVERSIDE WALK

Gravel pathway and lower riverside viewing area with interpretive signage.

13. NATURE PLAY SPACE

Imaginative nature play wonderland with shady She-oak 'fairy forest', sand and water play, islands and bridges, dedicated baby play area, climbing embankment and slides.

14. 'THE PENINSULA' PICNIC AREA

Feature shelter, BBQs and picnic tables for social gathering with views overlooking the Werribee River and nature play space below.

15. VIEWING DECK

3 metre wide continuous connection through the upper areas of the reserve for cyclists using the Werribee River Trail.

17. EASTERN PARK ENTRY

Generous shared space with feature paving, lawn areas, signage and other treatments to allow for safe pedestrian and cyclist movements.

18. PERIMETER WALK AND STAGE (OPTIONAL)

Wide gravel pathway (4m) with tree planting to define and create a backdrop to the edge of the events lawn. The 'walk' will help minimise impacts of foot traffic to adjacent sensitive natural areas, and provide additional space for events. A permanent events stage with power and lighting will be provided within this area.

19. SMALL EVENTS AREA

Flexible granitic gravel area providing for large event spill over space or small scale events.

21. PUBLIC TOILETS

A three cubical public toilet block will be provided in Area 10. Portable toilets will be brought in for events. Allowance has been made for an additional toilet block to be provided in future closer to the Adventure Playspace at location 21.
