

MY COMMUNITY..... MY STORY....



There are many in our community that find it hard to get out of bed every morning and face the daily grind and this month we would like to share a story of a local resident.

"Nancy is a local mother of seven children who has been suffering from depression for the last 5 years on and off and was on medications even through her last pregnancy. She said that medications didn't help as she only felt numb from all feelings and couldn't get up out of bed each morning. Her kids looked after her whilst she was sedated. She couldn't get the motivation to hang washing or clean the house and she was barely doing the basics of feeding her baby and changing nappies and just waiting for her kids to come from school to take over.

Her mental health worker suggested she should start getting out of her house and do some activity. She found the sewing class in Tarneit Community Learning Centre which is so affordable and with experienced

teachers. She joined the classes early last year and has now done three continuous courses and has found that going to the classes has taught her several skills, she can make clothing for her children and she has got her self esteem back. Due to the fact that she has seven children, she has learnt to make clothing for them and when she returns from class she makes more clothes in her own time for all of her children. After attending the classes for a while she told the doctors that her medications were not helping her and then they helped her wean herself off her medication and told her that she could come back anytime in three months if she had a relapse but it's going to be a year since she stopped her medications and she feels confident and has such a positive outlook on life. "

So she has suggested to others in her situation to please find some activity and meet people in your local community centre for a couple of hours each week and do the classes which are so affordable and be like her and see your life change for the better.


