The construction of the international terminal at Avalon Airport is fast approaching completion with flights to Kuala Lumpur due to commence on 5 December.

It is anticipated that the new terminal will accommodate 220,000 passengers per year, many of whom will head towards the Melbourne CBD. Capturing this new patronage

has the capacity to significantly impact Wyndham City's visitor economy with industry collaboration being a critical success factor.

As we move into warmer weather the Spring Racing Carnival provides opportunity for promotion of the city to a wider audience with the "international raiders" setting up home at the Werribee International Horse Centre.

A third tourism "game-changer" is the planned expansion of the Werribee Open Range Zoo. Funding was provided in the last state budget to develop a business case and master plan for the zoo. Among other things this includes a vision for a night zoo similar to the Singapore model with interactive and expanded animal experiences. These include Australian native animals and an open range enclosure for elephants.

Leveraging the opportunities that these and other emerging tourism offerings will deliver further enhance the city's position as a visitor destination for the international market. Confidence in the potential of the sector is perhaps no better demonstrated than the commitment of Holiday Inn to a 150- room hotel in the Werribee City Centre.

In development terms the growth of Avalon Airport has been a "slow burn" which through persistence and a commitment to success has reached a significant milestone. For Avalon Airport to continue its growth in both the domestic and international markets, Wyndham businesses and residents are well placed to support that growth through the utilisation of the airport for both business and recreation travel.

So let's all hop on board and support Avalon and the growth of the local visitor economy.

The team at Class Plastics has a lot to celebrate lately, after they scooped up not one but two awards at the recent 2018 Wyndham Business Awards. They took out the Manufacture Medium Award as well as the crowning Wyndham Business of the Year Award.

Daniel Carapellotti, Director CFO of Class Plastics accepted the awards with co-owner and Director of Operations Mario Nastri.

Complete Office Supplies, better known as COS, is a B2B supplier of office products including technology, kitchen and cleaning supplies, furniture, print and promotional items as well as general office supplies.

COS was founded in 1976 by Dominique Lyone, who fled to Australia after the 1967 six-day Arab-Israeli war. At the age of 22, Dominique started COS as a small stationery business in the garage of his home in Western Sydney. In those early days, COS had two staff members and typewriter ribbon was the top selling item.

Fast forward 41 years and COS is the second largest B2B office products company in Australia, selling 21,000 products and employing over 500 people.

"COS is still owned and managed by

Dominique, and his two daughters, Belinda and Amie, both hold executive roles in the business," said Joey George, Sales Manager at COS in Truganina.

In 2013, Dominique started the Lyone Foundation to share the success of COS and repay the kindness and support that his family received when they came to Australia.

"When we arrived from Egypt we needed lots of help. It's fair to say we wouldn't be here if it wasn't for charities like St Vincent de Paul," said Dominique.

"As a legacy of our journey here we started the Lyone Foundation with the bold goal of giving \$1m a year to charities in Australia to help others in need."

To date, the Lyone Foundation has contributed more than \$3m to charities such as Cottage by the Sea, The Australian Literacy and Numeracy Foundation, Spinal Muscular Atrophy Association of Australia, Wear for Success, Feel the Magic, Soldier On and The Gold Foundation.

COS has offices and warehouses in every state and territory, including their purpose-built logistics facility in Truganina which employs 90 staff, most of whom live in Melbourne's west.

Last year, COS invested \$1m in 1500 solar panels which generate solar energy that is equivalent to removing 133 cars a year from the road or growing more than 3100 trees.

"We are actively striving towards zero carbon emissions and the way energy prices are going our return on investment is likely to be quicker than expected" said Joey George.

This award-winning Wyndham-based business has more than 20,000 business customers including supply contracts with the Victorian State Government, the City of Greater Dandenong and the City of Greater Geelong.
