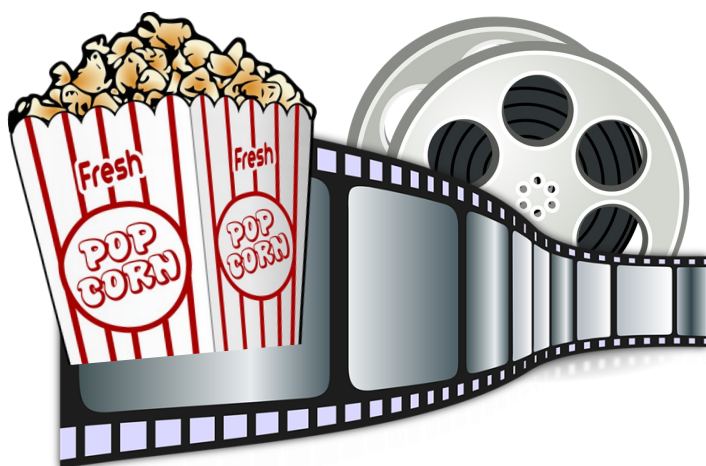

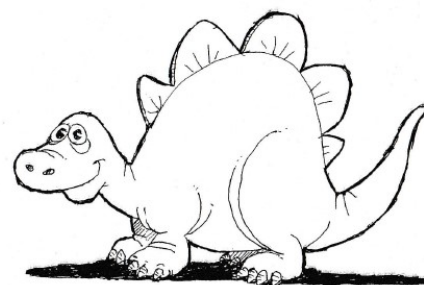

Goodbye - Saffron Kitchen

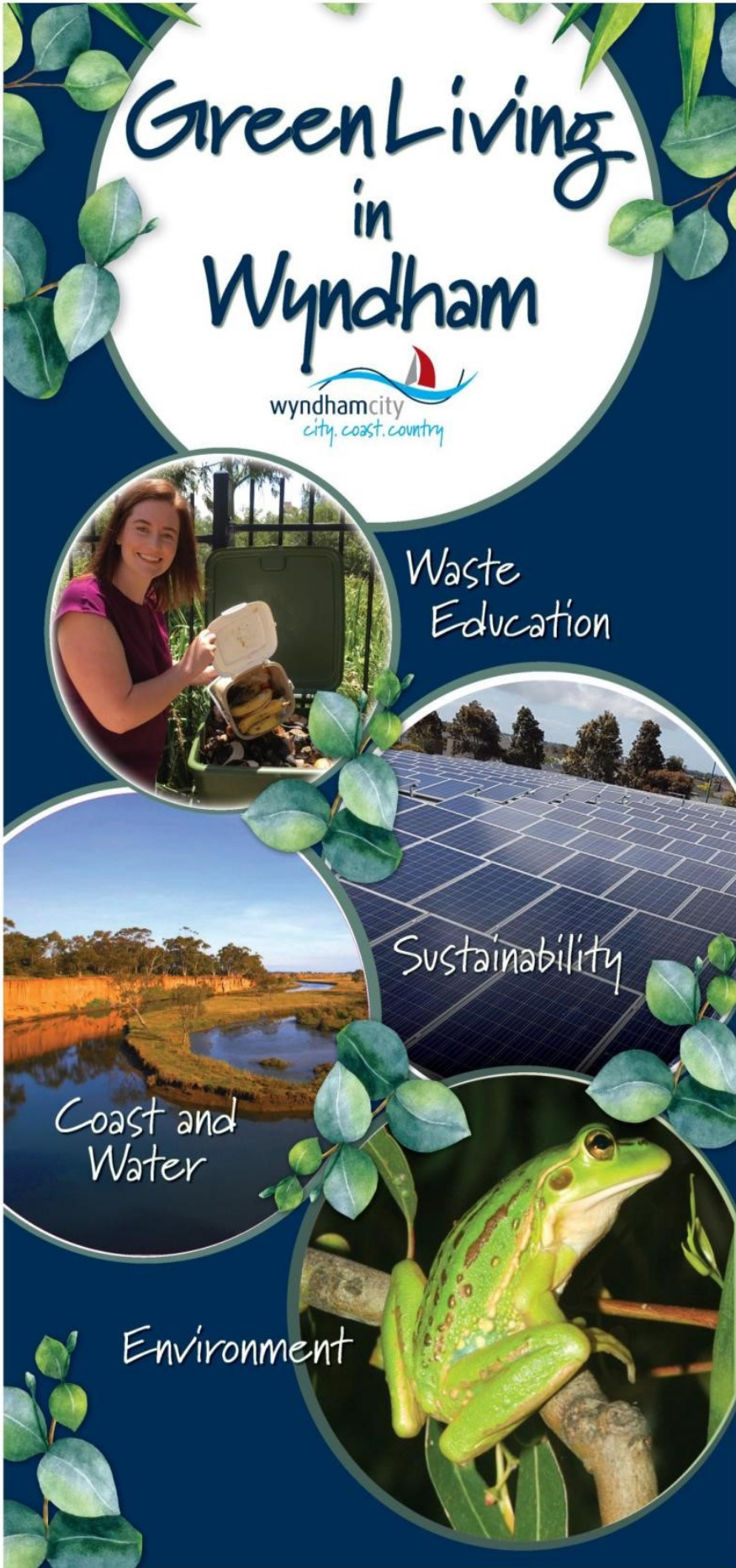
