Thanks for notice of Amendment C219 to the Wyndham Planning Scheme.

As you are probably aware, the Quandong Precinct includes several registered Aboriginal Places. All Aboriginal cultural heritage, whether registered or not, is protected under the Aboriginal Heritage Act 2006.

I note that there is a Registered Aboriginal Party approved Cultural Heritage Management Plan for this area (CHMP 13322). The activity detailed in this CHMP must comply with the recommendations of this CHMP, which are compliance requirements. Any other activities may require an amendment to the CHMP, a new CHMP or a Cultural Heritage Permit.

If you have any further questions, I suggest you contact your heritage advisors and the Wathaurung Aboriginal Corporation Registered Aboriginal Party.
