

The collective traditiona territory for the tribes of The Kulin Nation extends around Port Phillip and Western Port, up into The Great Dividing Range and the Loddon and Goulbourn river valleys.
Below is a listing of the language groups and the tribes associated with that language group.

Woiwurrung (Woy-wur-rung) - The Wurundjeri People

Boonrwrung (Bun-er-wrung) - The Bunurong or Boonerwrung People


Wathurrung (Wath-er-rung) - The Wauthaurong People

Daungwurrung (Tung-ger-rung) - The Taungurong People

Dja Dja Wrung (Jar-Jar - Wrung) - The Dja Dja Wurrung or Jaara People
