

Registration Renewal Fees:

Pet Registration Renewals are sent to owners at the beginning of March each year. Pet owners must ensure that payment is made to Council before 10 April. Below are current pet registration fees valid until 10 April 2020.

A State Government levy from the fees collected (\$2.50 for each cat registration and \$3.50 for each dog registration) is used to fund responsible pet ownership programs.

Evidence of Microchipping and Desexing (one discount per registration is applicable)

Lifetime Registration Tag

As part of this application you'll receive a lifetime registration tag which must be worn by your pet. The tag will be mailed to you within 7 days of your registration being received.

Guard Dogs on Commercial Property

A dog that is kept for the purpose of guarding non-residential premises is automatically a dangerous dog under the *Domestic Animals Act 1994*. Once a dog is deemed a dangerous dog it cannot be revoked - the dog is a dangerous dog for life, even if it ceases to be used for the purpose of guarding non-residential premises.
