After a whole year of renovations, the new and improved Tarneit Community Learning Centre has finally reopened its doors for the community to enjoy.

2020 will be an exciting year for the Tarneit community with a diverse range of events, services and activities on offer from the centre.

Some highlights include:

- Club 60, the Indian seniors friendship group, has returned to the Tarneit Community Learning Centre running three programs a week. Early in January, the group came together to celebrate their return to the place where the club began (see images below).
- In collaborating with the Salvation Army, Tarneit CLC will host its first Dad's Playgroup. Every Thursday, Dad's and male caregivers are encouraged to bring their young ones along to this fun, activity based, facilitated playgroup.
- Council Customer Service will continue at the centre, allowing local people to have greater access to all of Wynd ham's services. If you need to register an animal, apply for a building permit, pay your rates, enrol your child into kindergarten etc. come and talk to us from 9am—5pm, Monday to Friday.
