



PRESCHOOL FIELD OFFICER SERVICE

What is the Preschool Field Officer Service (PSFO)?

The PSFO service helps educators to build their confidence, knowledge and skills to provide an inclusive program that is responsive to the needs of all children. The service is funded by the Department of Education & Training and Wyndham City Council.

The PSFO service in Wyndham is available to educators requesting inclusion support for children in their care who are:

- ◆ Attending a state funded 4 year old kindergarten program in Wyndham, or
- ◆ 3 years of age by 30 April this year and attending an early childhood program in Wyndham such as long day care, 3+ activity group, playgroup or family day care.

What can we offer?

- ◆ Individual and Group support
- ◆ Inclusive teaching support, eg coaching, strategies, referral pathways for the family
- ◆ Meet and greet visits to new services in Wyndham that provide 3 & 4 year old programs
- ◆ Professional Development Workshops - in conjunction with the Wyndham Child and Family Services Network
- ◆ Inclusive teaching resources library for educators to borrow (free of charge)
