# Make your own games using paper plates.

# Make your own Ring Toss game! What you need:

- Paper plates
- Scissors
- Colouring materials
- Tape
- 1. Colour in a few paper plates. Make each one a different colour. These will be the rings that you toss.
- 2. Carefully cut the middle out the paper plates. You might need an adults help with this. Try folding the paper plate in half and cutting a slit, then unfold and you can use the slit to cut out the middle. You will have a hollow paper plate now.
- 3. To make the base grab a cardboard roll if you have one. If not roll up some paper.
- 4. Using another paper plate cut a small hole in the middle. The cardboard roll will fit through this hole. Use lots of tape to make it hold together.
- 5. You can then decorate the base.











### The Game:

Now to play ring toss. Place the base on the floor. Stand a certain distance away from the base. You can mark this with tape. Throw the rings at the base. How many can you land? You can see by the picture here that none of my rings landed! Try throwing the rings standing closer and standing further away from the base. Which one is harder?





# Make your own Naughts and Crosses game

This is a two player game

## You will need:

- 10 paper plates
- Drawing materials
- Something to mark the board out, like tape
- 1. On 5 paper plates draw the 'naught' or a zero.
- 2. On the other 5 plates draw the 'crosses'.
- 3. Mark out the board on the floor using something like tape, or ties from coats and dressing gowns. The board has 9 spots.

#### The Game.

- If you have never played before you can search online on how to play.
- To begin one player has the naughts and the other the crosses.
- Crosses goes first. Place your cross in a square.
- Then the player with naughts goes next and places their naught in a square.
- The objective of the game is to get 3 of you plates in a row. You can have 3 in a line up and down or diagonally.

• While playing remember to make sure the other player doesn't make 3 in a row. Sometimes you have to place your plate to block them so they don't win.
