A Tree in 4 Seasons

Have you noticed how trees change every season? In this activity we are going to create some artwork that shows how a tree changes over time.

What you need:

- paper (I used 4 A4 pieces)
- drawing supplies

What to do:

- 1. First you need to choose your tree. You can pick your favourite or use a tree in your backyard or neighbourhood. This example will be a jacaranda.
- 2. Go online and research your chosen tree and how its looks in summer, autumn, winter and spring. A jacaranda is a deciduous tree, meaning the leaves fall off over autumn. During summer in Melbourne the tree has purple flowers.
- 3. Now for the artwork! You can draw the tree across 4 pieces of paper and each paper will represent a season. Or draw 4 separate trees showing how it changes each season.
