How to make a Paper Plane!


Let's make a paper plane and see how far it can fly! You can follow these instructions, research online how to make a paper plane or make your own model if you like. Try making a few different models of paper planes and use different types of paper to see which one flies better.

What you need:


- paper. I used A4 notebook paper, but you can use any type
- colouring supplies to decorate your plane
- 1. Fold your paper in half lengthways then unfold.




2. Fold the two top corners down to the centre fold.




3. Do the same again. Fold the slanted edge into the centre fold.




4. Your plane should now look like this



5. Fold the plane in half along the fold line you made in Step 1.



6. Fold the top slanted edge down to the bottom edge. Repeat on the other side.



7. This is what the plane looks like now.



8. Finished! Now to decorate your plane and see how far it goes. Mark a spot and stand behind it. Measure how far your plane flies. Get everyone in your household to try and see who can fly their plane the farthest.
