

## What can you see?

Grab some paper and all your drawing supplies! Today we are going to see how colours appear different on black paper compared to white paper.

## What you need:

- pens, pencils, pastels, crayons, textas, paints, chalk, whatever you have to draw with.
- white paper, black paper, coloured paper.

Have a look at my examples on the next page. I used oil pastels, metallic oil pastels, fluro oil pastels, textas, metallic textas, colour pencils and watercolour paints.

## What can you see?

- All colours are brighter on the white paper.
- The metallic textas look silver on black paper.
- You can't see the colour textas on black paper..
- The watercolour paint only showed on black paper when it was dry.

If you don't have black or coloured paper try colouring in a section of paper with black pencil or texta. See how colours show up on the black coloured section. So go work on your next masterpiece!
