

Grow a Succulent!

Do you have succulents in your backyard? Did you know you can grow a new succulent from just one cutting? If you have succulents in your backyard pull off the smaller part of it (the child) from the larger part (the mother) and that is the cutting that you will grow the new plant from. I decided to plant mine in a teacup. Remember when working in the garden with soil to wear gloves and wash your hands with soap when you are finished. Succulents do not need a lot of water, so only water when the soil is dry.
