

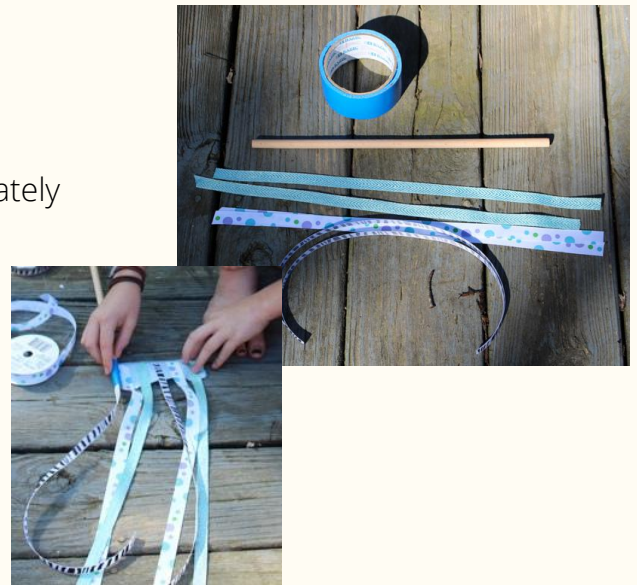
Homemade Pet Toys

Spoil your pet by making them a toy yourself with some household upcycled materials! Below you will find out how to make a cat dangler and dog tug toy! Older kids can make these on their own but smaller kids might need a bit of help.

Here's how to make a cat dangler

You will need: dowel stick or cardboard tube (Approximately 12" is a good length) ribbons (or strips of old material) scissors and some duct tape.

To assemble: Cut off a piece of duct tape and stick ribbon pieces along the top of it. Wrap the duct tape around one end of the dowel or cardboard tube. Done!



Here's how to make a dog tug toy

You will need: old material, like a t-shirt or cloth that you no longer want, scissors.

To assemble: cut the material into three strips. Tie the strips together at one end. Braid the strips together and tie at the other end. Done!
