Origin

Cultivar originating in Kings Park, Perth

Characteristics

Narrow, elliptical leaves, slightly pendulous branches. Drooping crimson flowers, profuse in spring with some flowering into summer.

Tolerances

High tolerance of drought once established. Generally, frost tolerant except young shoots in severe frost.

Suitable for use under powerlines: Suitable

Description

Typical height: 3-5 metres

Typical width: 3-5 metres

Growth rate: Fast

Typical form: Narrow, domed canopy; typically, multi-stemmed

Facts and Trivia

Registered as a cultivar in 1980 by the Kings Park and Botanic Garden in Perth, Western Australia, although the origin of the seed is unknown. Likely parentage includes C. viminalis and C. citrinus.

Another similar cultivar is C. 'Harkness' which has broader, more leathery leaves and is reportedly less floriferous in Western Australia.
