Origin

Along watercourses from northern Qld to north-east NSW.

Characteristics

Evergreen large shrub to small tree. Young leaves covered in downy hairs, sometimes bronzered. Crimson flowers in summer.

Tolerances

High tolerance of waterlogging, soil compaction, and heavy wind load.

Suitable for use under powerlines: Suitable.



Description

Typical height: 4-6 metres (up to 15m in natural habitat)

Typical width: 4-5 metres

Growth rate: Moderate

Typical form: Pendulous, somewhat open crown

Facts and Trivia

Numerous cultivars available, many as compact shrubs ('Little John', 'McArthur'). 'Hannah Ray' is a commonly available strongly weeping form. Narrow forms also available for constrained sites (e.g. 'Slim')
