Origin

Hybrid, developed in France

#### **Characteristics**

Leaves emerge reddish purple, becoming greener over summer. Flowers are big, pink and semidouble. Fruit not produced.

#### Tolerances

Susceptible to fruit-tree borer and Shot Hole fungal disease. Low tolerance to wind.

Suitable for use under powerlines: Suitable.



#### Description

Typical height: 5 metres

Typical width: 4-5 metres

Growth rate: Fast growing when young

Typical form: Small deciduous, vase-shaped tree. Can become irregular and gnarled.

### Facts and Trivia

Developed around 1895 by Lemoine in France, it is a cross between the Japanese Apricot (Prunus mume) and the Purple-leaved Plum (Prunus cerasifera 'Pissardii').
