Origin

Native to eastern Asia.

Characteristics

Small, glossy, dark green leaves.
Orange-brown flaking bark

Tolerances

High drought and frost
tolerance. Tolerates
compaction and a restricted
root zone.

Facts and Trivia

Unaffected by Elm Leaf Beetle.
Wind pollinated and wind-dispersed
with samaras that gain distance
by spinning like a propeller. Wind
pollinated trees are of little interest to
grazing birds or insects.
