

JACK O' LANTERN

Get into the Halloween spirit by making some paper jack o'lanterns to decorate your house with!

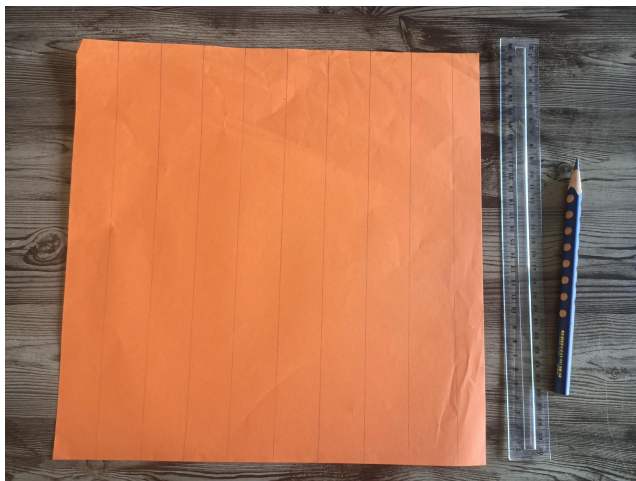
What you need:

- Paper. I used orange paper for my big jack o'lantern and coloured white paper orange for my small jack o'lantern.
- Drawing supplies
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Stapler, glue or sticky tape

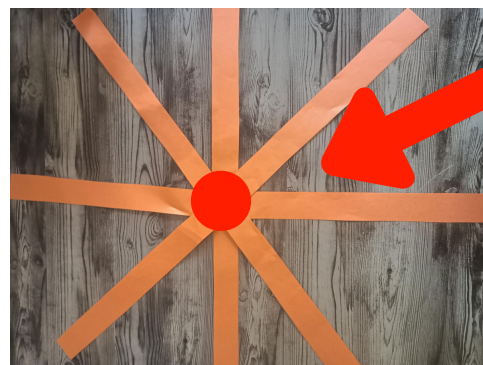


What to do:

- Colour in your paper. You can make your jack o'lantern whatever colour you like!
- Using a ruler and pencil rule lines down your paper. I made mine a ruler width apart.
- Cut out along the lines. You will need 8 strips of paper.



- Lay the strips out to make a star shape like the picture. Now staple, glue or tape together in the centre. I found stapling the easiest.

- Now for the tricky part! To make the shape 3D you will need to attach the other ends together, like you just did in the middle. Look at the picture below. See how I have curved the strips around and all the ends meet. Staple these together. It is hard to hold all the ends together so I stapled them in groups of two, then added the other strips on top and stapled again.



- I used leftover paper to colour in and cut out some green leaves. Then I drew a face on my smaller jack o'lantern.
