



Photography Challenge

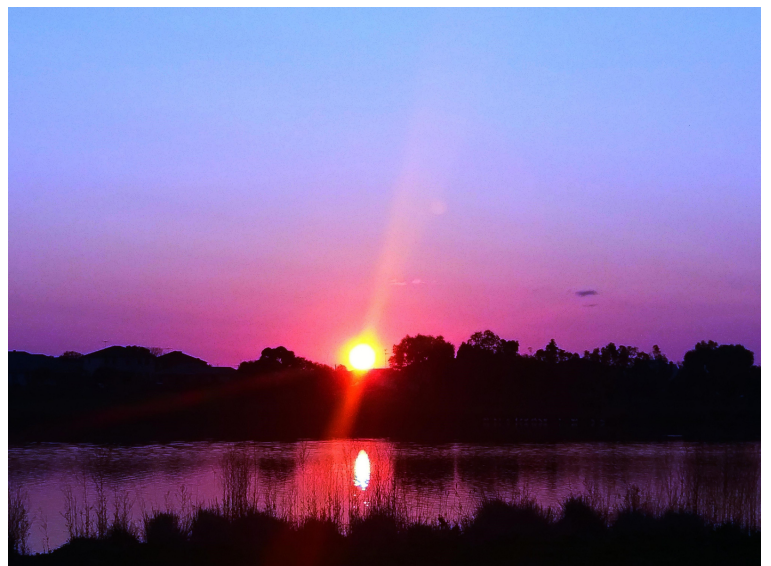
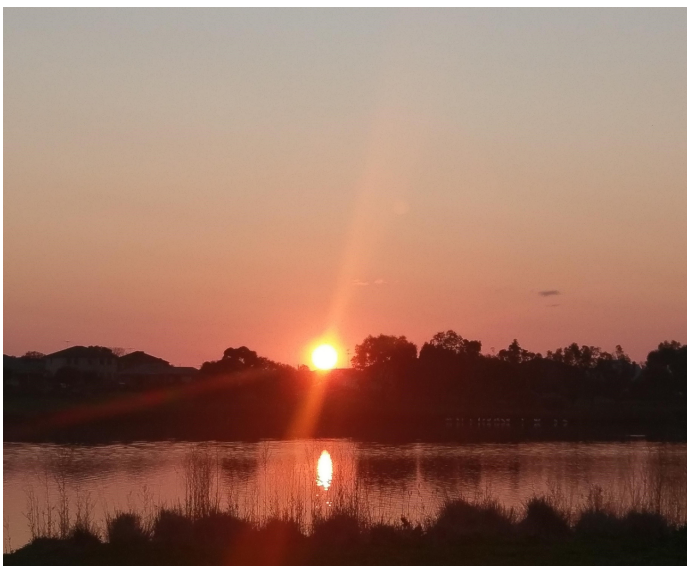
Photography is a fun art where you can get creative with light and image. Grab yourself a camera or device and complete our photography challenge. Upload your photos to the [Kids Club Online Gallery](#).

Take a photo of:

1. Five different objects that are the same colour.
2. Something with your eyes closed.
3. The same object at different times of the day.
4. Something you find interesting and then draw a picture.
5. A silly self portrait.
6. Your street sign.
7. An insect in your garden.
8. The same subject with the flash on then the flash off (flash on a camera is the lightning button).
9. Something using the panorama mode. This is where you take the photo and then move the camera to the side so it makes the photo longer. It is good to use when taking photos of nature.
10. Lights in the dark using night mode.
11. The sunset, then edit the photo and see how bright you can make the colours.
12. Something using the different filters your camera has. Which is your favourite?

Here is an example of how you can edit an image on your phone. I took this photo of the sunset here. For the second photo I went into the editing part of my phone photo gallery and played around with the options. I increased the contrast and saturation, and decreased the brightness and colour temperature. Then I added a filter that made the colours more purple. If you don't know how to do this ask for an adult's help.



What other ways can you make your photos look different? Here I zoomed in on Pikachu's face so it filled the whole screen. I edited the second photo to make it black and white.



Here are some other activities you can do with photography:

- **Photo jigsaw puzzle!** If you have a printer at home make your photo A4 size, print it off and cut up the photo to make a jigsaw puzzle.
- **Photo frame.** Make a photo frame to display your favourite photo.
- **Photo story.** Choose a topic for your story and take photos. You can write a story to go with the photos or just use the photos to tell the story.
- **Toy Story.** Take your favourite toy on an adventure! Take photos of what they get up too.
