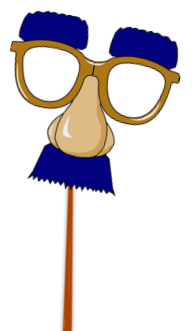
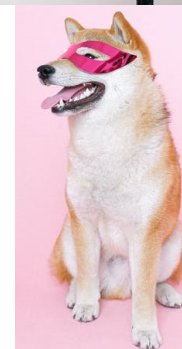
You can use props such as wigs, hats, sunglasses, feather boas, fake noses or even costumes.

Or, you might like to print out the following pages of images to create your own photo booth props.

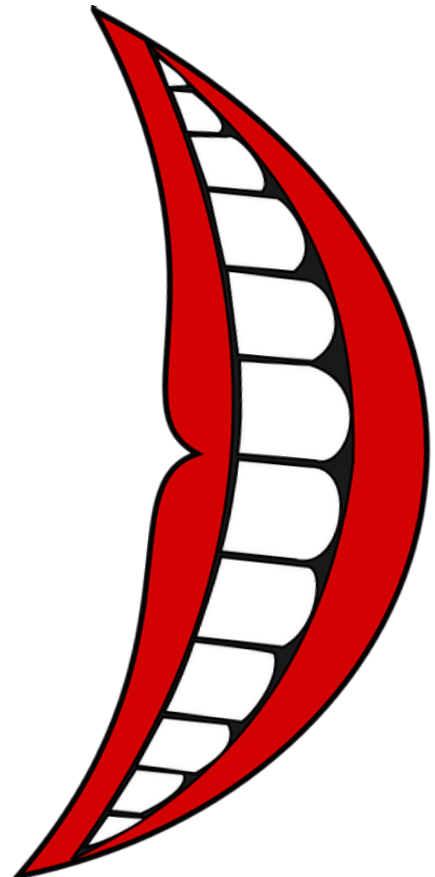
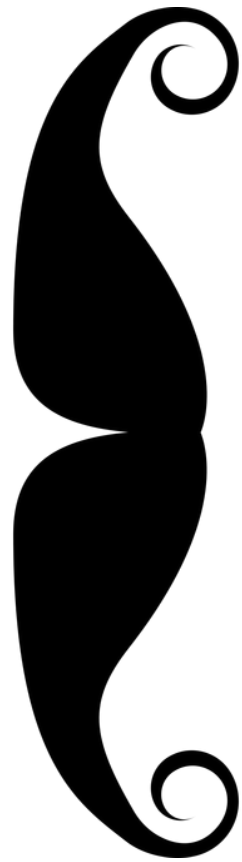
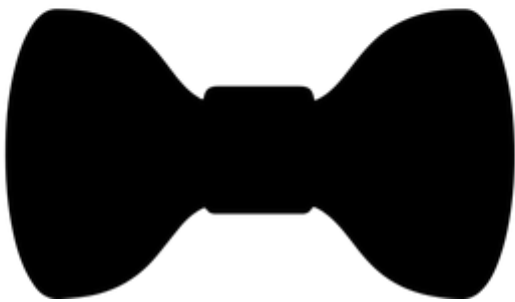
