

Have a Scandi Christmas









At Christmas time in Scandinavia, it is common for families to make their own decorations, to hang on their tree or hang around their home. Making decorations out of straw and paper is popular, as is decorating with candles, baubles, apples, and gnomes in red hats.



Families cut out Christmas shapes in glossy paper and they are hung from the tree. Similar shapes are used when making biscuits too.



You can decorate your tree and table the Scandinavian way. Think about using natural elements such as pinecones, brown paper packages tied up with string, homemade biscuits, paper or fabric bunting, twinkle lights, fruit and nuts, and other elements from nature.



You might even like to use a plant in a pot and decorate it with paper or ribbons and other homemade ornaments.
