

Suncatcher



Using some PVA glue and paint we are going to make an awesome suncatcher!

What you need:

- Plastic plate or lid (like a clean yoghurt or ice cream container lid).
- Acrylic paint or poster paints
- Food dye
- PVA glue

What to do:

1. Cover your work surface with old newspaper. We are going to get messy! Pour PVA glue onto the plastic lid and swirl it around so it covers the entire lid. I didn't have a plastic lid to use so I covered a paper plate with cling wrap and poured the glue onto that.
2. Put drops of paint onto the glue. If you don't have paint you can use food dye. I used both.
3. Using a skewer or end of a pencil or paintbrush swirl the paint around a little to make a marble effect.
4. Now put the lid somewhere safe to dry. It takes about 3 or 4 days to dry!
5. When the glue is dry carefully peel it off the lid. Punch a hole in the suncatcher and thread some string through so you can hang it up somewhere sunny.
