Can you turn milk into plastic?

In this experiment we are going to see what happens when we mix milk with vinegar.

What you need:

- 1 cup hot milk (microwave about 1 minute)
- 4 tablespoons of vinegar
- Strainer
- Optional: food dye

What to do:

- 1. Mix the 4 tablespoons of vinegar into the hot milk in a bowl. Add a very small amount of food dye if you want. I used red. You will notice that the mixture smells and looks **gross!**
- 2. Keep stirring! The milk will start to clump up when the acid in the vinegar breaks down the protein in the milk.
- 3. Now strain the milk through a strainer. Use a spoon to push the clumps so all the liquid drains out.
- 4. Gather the hard clump and use paper towel to remove any more liquid. You can shape the milk clump with your hands. I made a flower and a snail. Leave it for a couple of days to dry and see what happens!
