COMIC ART



For this activity we are going to make an artwork based on pop art and comic book styles.

What you need:

- Coloured paper. Bright primary and secondary colours work well.
- Textas
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Glue

What to do:

- 1. Choose what word you would like to use for this artwork. Comic words are descriptive of actions and sounds like 'Boom!' 'Zap!' 'Crash!' 'Wow!'
- 2. Draw a speech bubble or cloud shape on white paper that fills up most of the page. Go over the edge lines with black texta to make them thick. Add a pattern to the shape if you want. I drew blue dots. Cut it out.





3. Write your word using big letters. I outlined my word with thick black lines and coloured it in yellow. Cut it out.

4. Next draw another speech bubble or cloud. I choose to draw a spiky one this time. Then I cut it out and stuck it to red paper then cut it out again so there is a red outline around the speech bubble. If you don't have coloured paper you can just colour the outline in a different colour.

5. Now draw some shapes for you artwork. I drew some long red and yellow triangles. I added some patterns on some of the triangles. Cut the shapes out.

6. It's time to create your artwork! Do not glue anything down just yet. Rearrange all your shapes on a piece of background paper until you are happy with your layout. Then you can glue everything down. If you want to make your artwork really pop and have a 3D appearance you can use foam tape or fold up some scrap paper and tape it to the back so the shapes sit off the page.
