PAPER PLATE CROCODILE

What you need:

- Three paper plates
- A4 Paper
- Colouring supplies
- Scissors
- Glue/tape/stapler

What to do:

- 1. Colour in the paper plates. I coloured the body of my crocodile green, and the other plate which will be the mouth is green on one side and red on the other.
- 2. Draw teeth across the long length of the paper. Draw some large eyes. Cut them out.
- 3. To make the mouth of the crocodile, fold the paper plate in half. Then I used tape to stick the teeth to the edge of the red side.
- 4. To attach the mouth to the body, I used glue and staples to stick the folded plate on one half of the green plate. Then I used tape to attach the eyes above. You can make the crocodile's mouth open and close. Snap! Snap!
