

BUBBLE SNAKES

This activity is best done outside as it can get messy!

Materials:

- Empty plastic water bottle that you don't mind cutting up
- Duct tape or a large rubber band or an old hair tie
- Scissors
- An old sock
- Dishwashing liquid
- A shallow container
- Water
- Food colouring (optional)



**Remember to blow out and not in when using the bubble blower otherwise you will get the bubble mixture in your mouth. Yuck!
Small children will need supervision.**

Instructions:

1. Carefully cut off the bottom end of the bottle.



2. Slide the sock onto the end of the plastic bottle and secure it with duct tape, a rubber band or a hair tie.



3. Pour some dishwashing liquid into the shallow container, add a little bit of water and mix together.



4. Dip the sock end of the bottle into the soap mixture and allow the sock to soak up some of the liquid.



5. Gently blow through the bottle neck. See how long you can make your bubble snake!



6. To make a rainbow bubble snake add some food colour drops to the sock!
