Stained Glass Window



When I was a kid I loved making these paper and cellophane stained glass windows. I would make a few and stick them to the big windows at the front of my house using blu-tack!

What you need:

- Black paper
- Cellophane (you can buy this from craft shops and places that sell wrapping paper)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Ruler and pencil

What to do:

- 1. Rule a border around the piece of black paper. If you don't have black paper then you can colour white paper black. Or use whatever colour you want!
- 2. Cut out the middle part of the paper so you have a rectangle of paper and the border. Now cut the rectangle into strips a little smaller than your border. Stick the strips in sections along the border so you have different size shapes inside the border.
- 3. Cut the cellophane into pieces so they are slightly bigger then the shape they will cover. Glue around the edges and stick the cellophane down and trim if needed. Do this so all shapes are covered.
- 4. Turn the paper over and now you have a stained glass window. Take a picture of it and show us on the <u>Kids Club Online Gallery</u>.
