What you need:

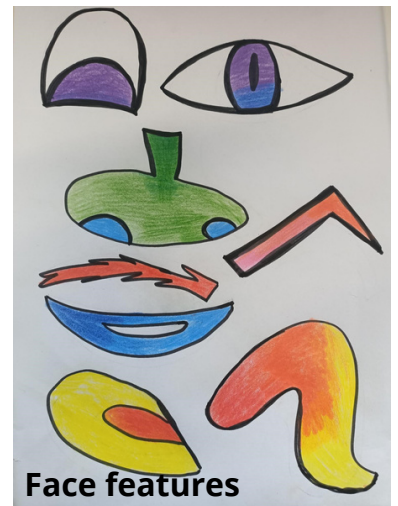
- Paper
- Colouring supplies
- Scissors
- Glue

What to do:

1. Draw out facial features on paper and colour them in. I used three sheets of paper for mine because I wanted my face to have big exaggerated features. Have fun with this! You don't have to make them look human. I have one dog ear in my drawing, two different shaped eyes and different style eyebrows. Abstract art is very bright and colourful so use a lot of colours here.
2. When you are finished colouring, cut all the shapes out.
3. Decide where all the shapes will go on the head before you glue them down. Remember you don't need to make your face look 'human'. The weirder the better!
