Roll Plane


Paper rolls (from toilet paper and paper towel) are great to use in craft. Make sure you save them and add to your <u>Recycled Junk</u> <u>Craft Box</u>.


What you need:

- Paper roll
- Paper
- Colouring supplies
- Scissors
- Sticky tape

What to do:

- 1. Colour in your roll. I painted mine.
- 2. On the paper you can draw and colour in shapes to make the wings, propeller and the fin shapes for the tail. Cut them out.
- 3. Roll up 4 small bits of paper around a pencil and use sticky tape to hold it together. Slide off the pencil. These will be to join the wings.
- 4. Stick everything together to make your plane. I used tape because it is stronger than glue.
