

Paper Roll Rocket

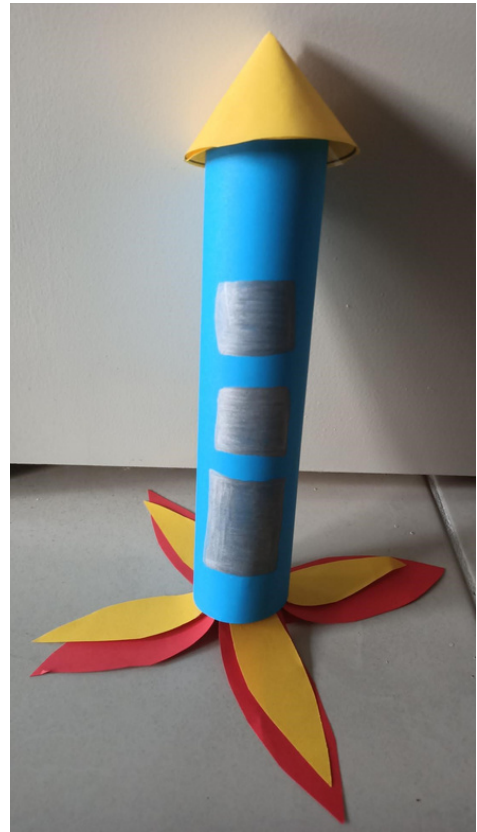
Let's make a rocket to launch into space!

You will need:

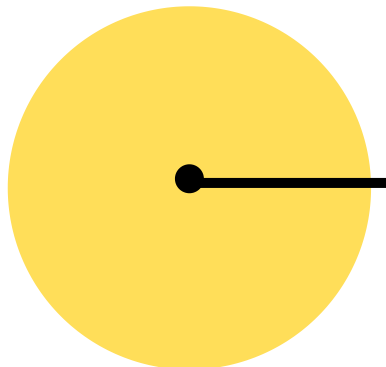
- Paper roll (I save paper rolls from the inside of paper towel and toilet paper to use in crafts)
- Coloured paper. If you do not have coloured paper you can use white paper and colour it in, or colour directly onto the roll
- Glue/sticky tape
- Scissors

What to do:

1. Cover the paper roll with paper, or colour in a design for the rocket.



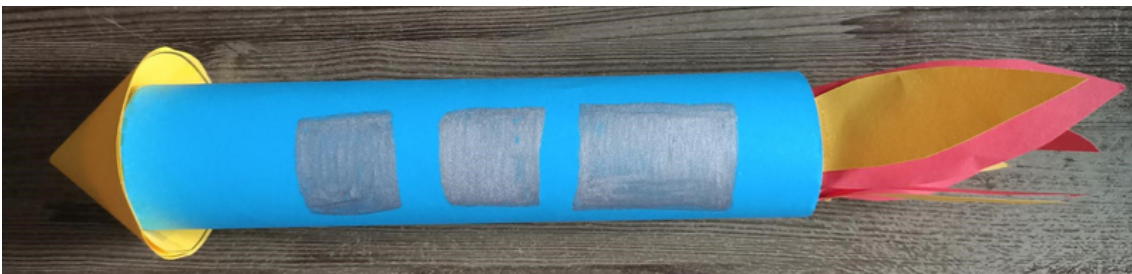
2. To make the top of the rocket you will need a circle. I traced around a large cup. My paper roll is 21 cm long and the diameter of the circle is 10.5cm, so half the size of the roll. Make a dot in the centre of the circle, then draw a line to the edge. Cut along this line to the dot in the middle.



3. Shape the paper so it makes a cone shape. Glue or tape so it stays in place. Attach to the top of the rocket using tape.

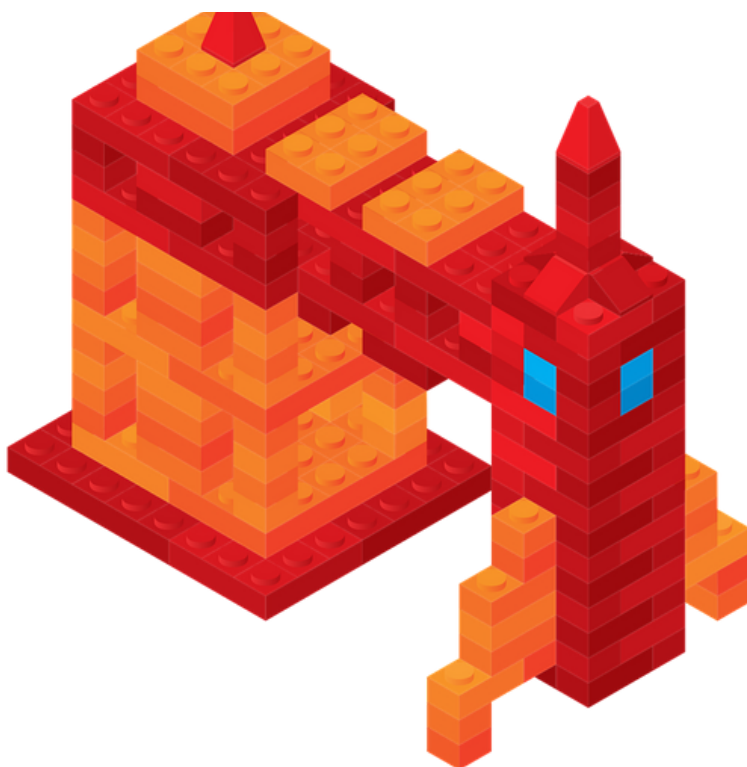
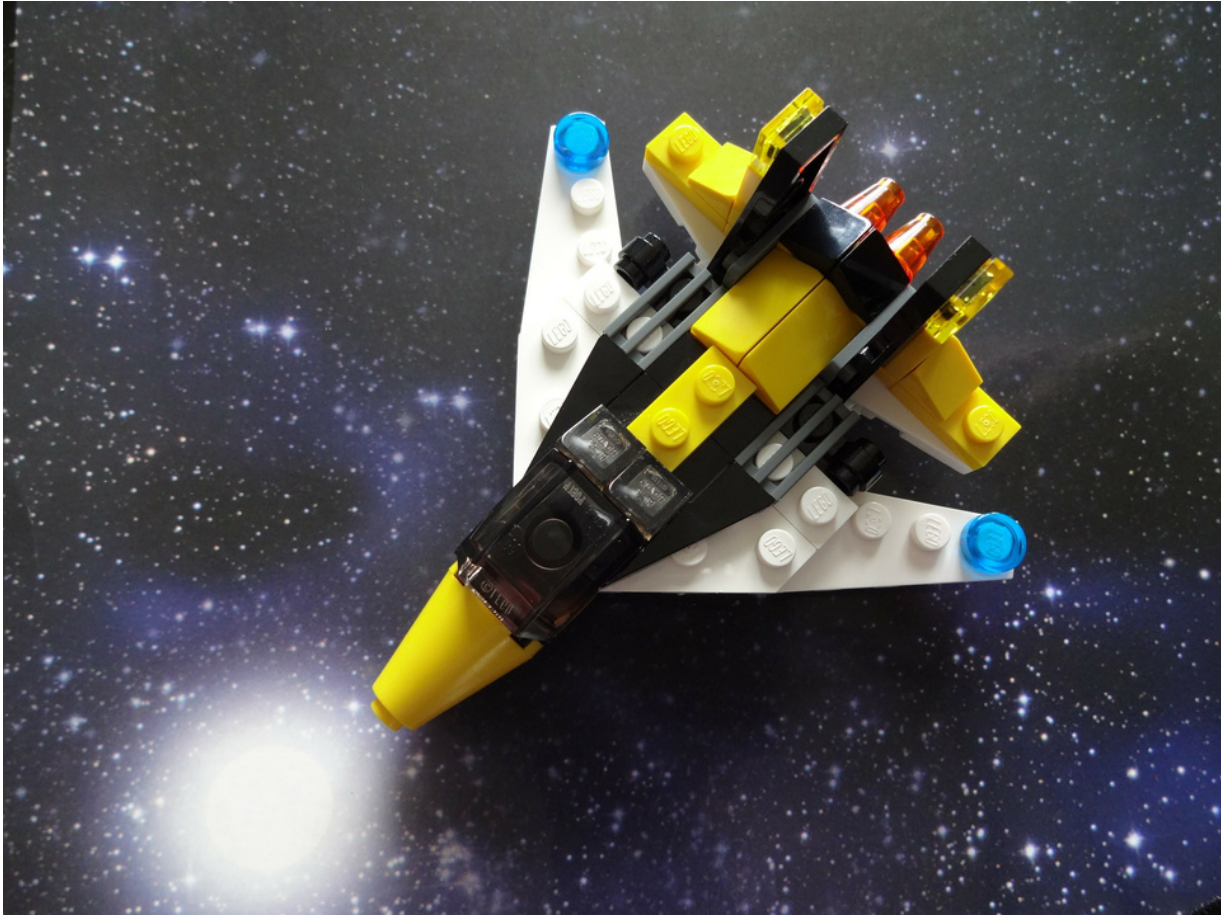


4. Colour in and cut out fire and flame shapes for the tail of the rocket. Stick these inside the end of the roll. You can add some more details to your rocket if you like. Maybe an alien? Show us a photo on the [Kids Club Online Gallery](#).
