Make your own games using paper plates.

Make your own Ring Toss game! What you need:

- Paper plates
- Cardboard roll
- Scissors
- Colouring materials
- Tape

What to do:

- 1. Colour in a few paper plates. Make each one a different colour. These will be the rings that you toss.
- 2. Carefully cut out the middle of the paper plates. You might need an adult's help with this. Try folding the paper plate in half and cutting a slit, then unfold and you can use the slit to cut out the middle. You will have a hollow paper plate now.
- 3. Using another paper plate, cut a small hole in the middle. The cardboard roll will fit through this hole. Use lots of tape to make it hold together. If you don't have a cardboard roll, you can roll up a sheet of paper.
- 4. You can then decorate the base.
- 5. Take a photo and show us on the Kids Club Online Gallery!











How to play:

Time to play ring toss! Place the base on the floor. Stand a certain distance away from the base. You can mark this with tape.

Throw the rings at the base. How many can you land? You can see by the picture here that none of my rings landed!

Try throwing the rings standing closer, and standing further away from the base. Which one is harder?
