Christmas at the Lakes	Christmas At the Lakes - Connecting Our Community	\$5,000	A community event providing an opportunity for attendees to reengage and reconnect with others in the community, which will support the community to recover. The event is open to all multi-cultural groups and supports local performing artists, sporting and service clubs.

Waiata Waananga by Breanne Peters	\$4,930.97	An 8-week Maori musical theory program where participants will learn about composition and musical theory, then showcase their creations to friends and family at the conclusion of the program.
