

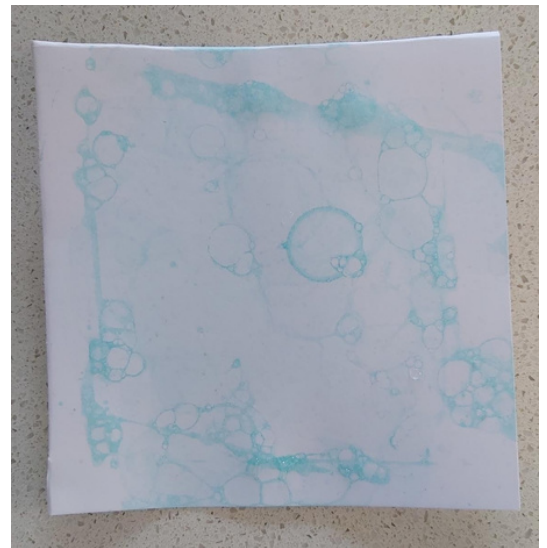
# Bubble Painting

## What you need:

- Bubble mix or dish soap and water
- Straw
- Card paper or thicker than normal paper
- Tempera (water-based) paint or food dye
- Deep tub or plastic tray \***This will get dirty, ask an adult**

## What to do:

- Place a shallow layer of bubble mix (or dish soap and water) in the bottom of your plastic container.
- Squeeze in some paint (or food dye) and then use your drinking straw to blow a mound of colourful bubbles. **Get an adult to help with this step. Be careful not to drink the liquid up the straw! Just blow through the straw!**
- When you're ready to capture your art, you can gently press a piece of card over the top of your bubbles, to take a monoprint. Don't press the card down too hard or leave on for too long or you will end up with a soggy card and the bubble print will be lost.
- You can let the first print dry and then re-dip the same piece of card on top of another set of bubbles, perhaps with a different colour of paint added in, to layer up the colours on your print.
