

Craft box Jewellery

Wish you had something different to wear? Looking for something new to make?

Try making some craft box jewellery.

In my craft box, I have safety pins, ribbon, elastic, buttons, pipe cleaners, scraps of fabric, thread and pom poms.

When old clothes wear out, I cut off the buttons and keep them in my craft box. I can then upcycle them when sewing or doing craft.

You can use items from your craft box to make a necklace, a ring, a brooch or a bracelet. Or any type of jewellery you think would look cool.

If you have loom bands you can use them make cool jewellery as well.

Make a ring

You will need:

Buttons and pipe cleaners



Choose a large button.

Thread the pipe cleaner through the button hole.

Make a loop for your finger and twist the pipe cleaner to hold the loop shape.

Cut off any excess pipe cleaner.

Repeat this process with different coloured buttons and pipe cleaners. You might use more than one button at a time.

























Make a choker

You will need: Buttons and ribbons

Method:

Choose a large button or two different coloured buttons

Measure enough ribbon to go around your neck and tie in a bow.

Cut off any excess ribbon.

Thread the ribbon through the buttonhole(s).

Tie knots in the ribbon to secure the buttons.

Repeat this process with different coloured buttons and different width ribbon.
