

Harry Potter Bookmark.

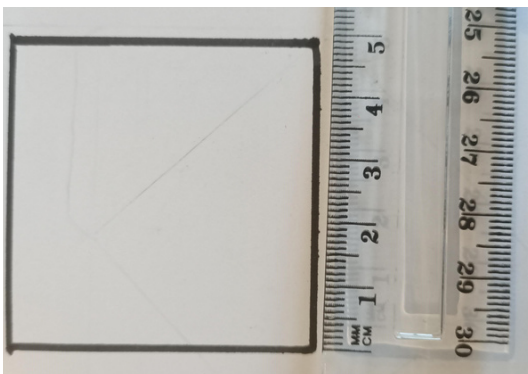
This is a simple technique to make a bookmark that sits on the corner of your page.

What you need:

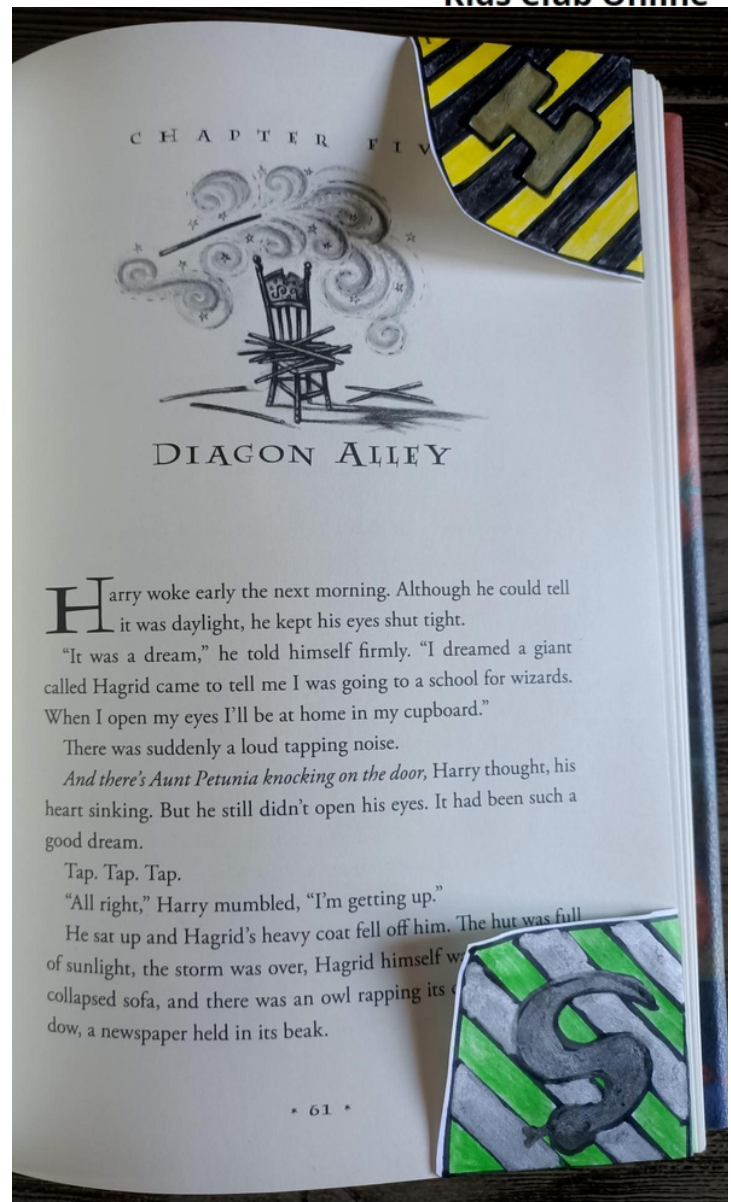
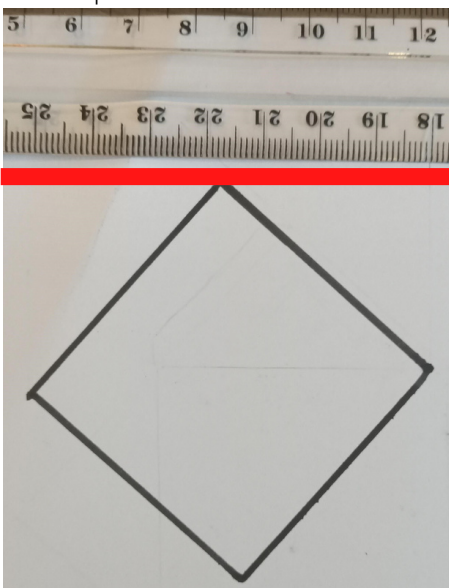
- Paper
- Pencils/textas
- Scissors
- Glue or sticky tape
- Ruler

What to do:

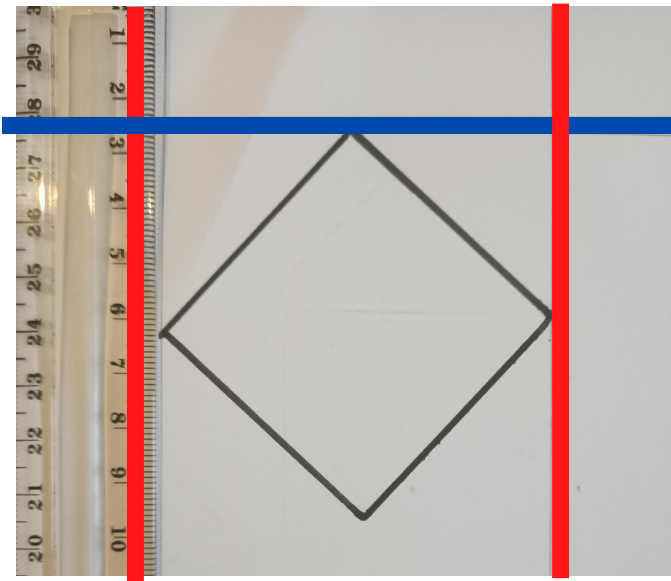
1. Draw a square that is 5cm long on every side. Look at the images below to help you draw the lines in the right places. Flip the paper around so your square is a diamond.



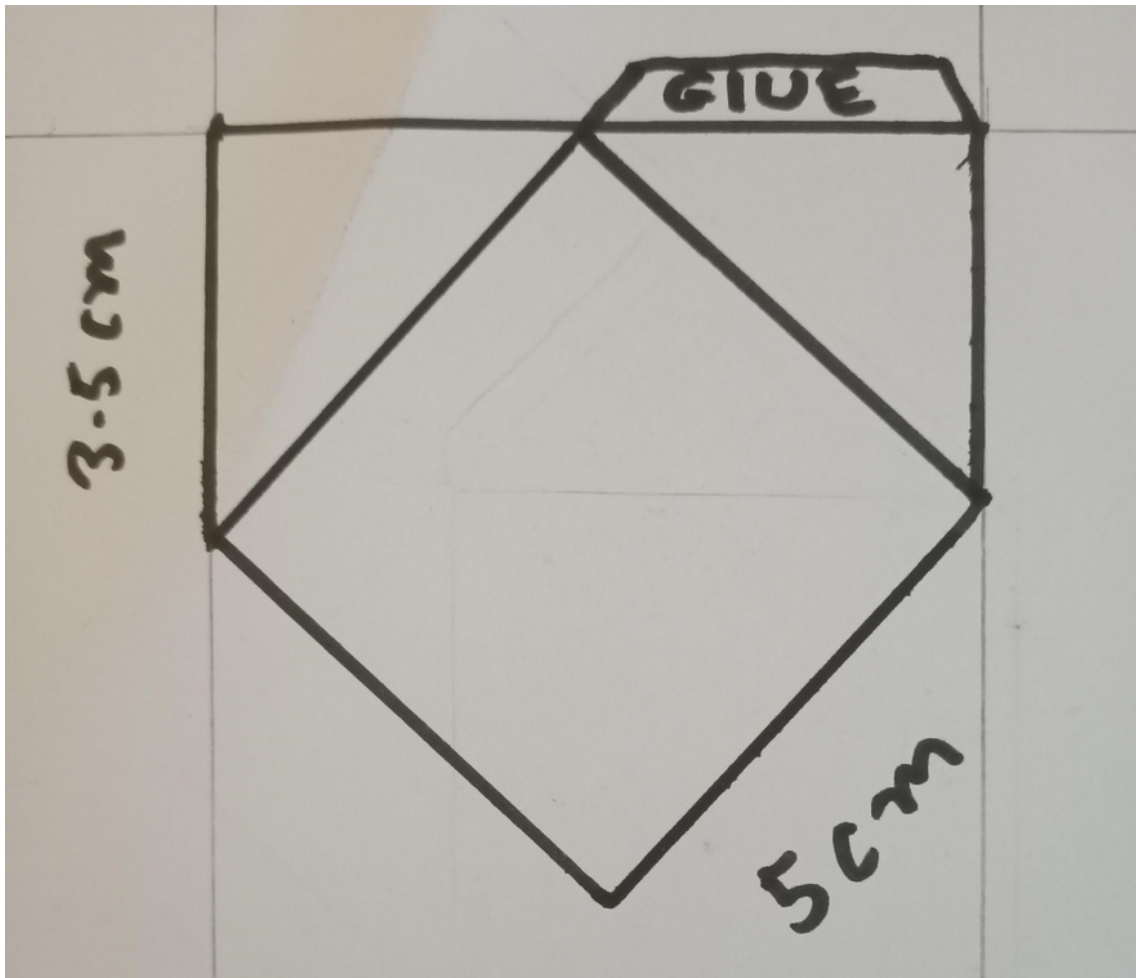
2. Place your ruler across the top point of the diamond and draw a line, like the red line in the picture below.



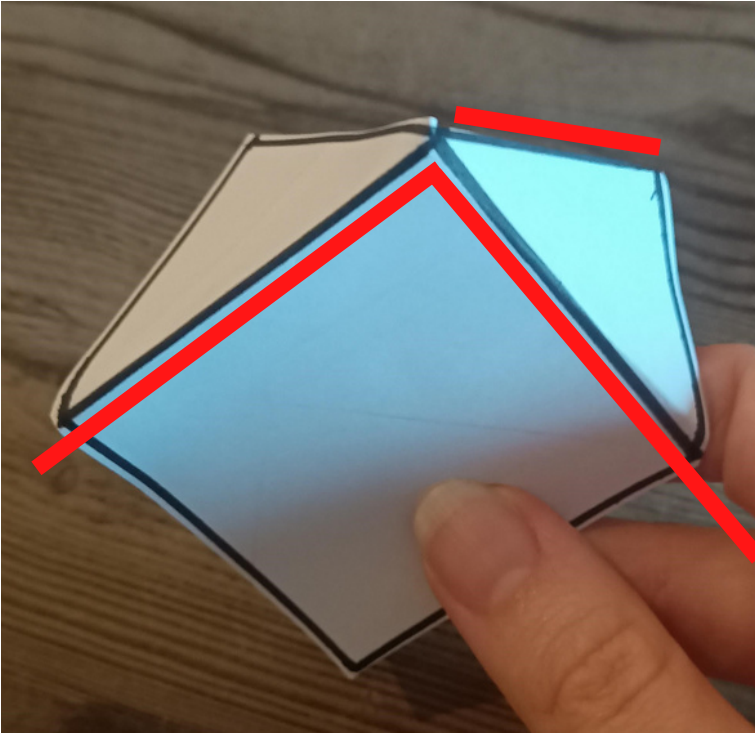
3. Now rule a line along the point on the side of the diamond. Continue the line so it meets with the line across the top you just drew. Repeat on the other side. Now you have two triangles on the top sides of the diamond.



4. Add a tab for glue along the top edge of one of the triangles. I have gone over the lines in black that will make the bookmark so you can see what it will look like. Cut out along the black lines along the edge.



5. Fold along the edges marked in red. Also fold the Glue tab and glue to close the two triangles together.



6. Decorate your bookmark! You could colour the bookmark in the colours of your Hogwarts House, or your favourite magical animal in the Harry Potter books. Add photos to the [Kids Club Online Gallery](#).
