Make your own magic wand!

If you can't go to Ollivanders to buy your wand you can make one at home!

What you need:

- Paper
- Colouring supplies
- Tape
- Optional: things to decorate your wand with (sequins, ribbons, wool)

How to make your wand:

- 1. Colour in some paper. I used A4 size. I only coloured in half because you roll up the paper so you don't need to colour the whole piece. I wanted my wand to look like it was made from wood so I used brown and added some black lines.
- 2. Roll up the paper to make a wand shape and use tape to stick together.
- 3. Decorate your wand and give it a go! Take a photo pf your wand and upload to the Kids Club

Wand facts:

- Ollivanders used three core ingredients in his wands; phoenix feather, dragon heartstring or unicorn tail hair.
- The Elder Wand is the only known wand to have a core of Thestral hair.
- Harry's wand has a phoenix feather core, both of Ron's wands have a core of unicorn hair and Hermione's has dragon heartstring.
- If an underage witch or wizard is expelled from Hogwarts, their wand is confiscated and destroyed. Hagrid keeps the broken pieces of his wand in his umbrella.
- Lord Voldemort and Harry's wand have a twin core. Both have a phoenix feather donated by Dumbledore's phoenix Fawkes.
